


HF 665 USER GUIDE

Thank you for selecting Bluetooth headset HF 665

HF 665 stereo Bluetooth headset make you have more interaction&entertainment in your own music space, and synchronize your work in hand.at the same time after paired with the compatible mobile.

HF 665 Bluetooth headset is compliant with Bluetooth Version 2.1 +EDR(Enhanced Data Rate)
and is compatible with latest mobile phones supporting Bluetooth headset or hands-free profiles.



Getting Started HF 665

Prior to using the Bluetooth headset, please follow the steps below:

1. Ensure your Bluetooth headset is fully charged.
2. Pair your charged Bluetooth headset with a Bluetooth-enable mobile phone, prior to using Bluetooth headset for the first time,it is suggested that you fully recharge the battery first.

Charging Your Headset

Rechargeable battery with Micro-USB charging option from AC power supply, PC via USB cable, the indicator will turn red when charging. Usually it needs 2-3h to be fully charged and the red indicator shut down.

Turning on the headset

Press and hold the MFB for 3 seconds until the blue indicator display to turn it on.(Repeat to turn it off)

About pairing function, please refer to "Pairing Your Headset".

Pairing Your Headset

The headset works with Bluetooth-enable phones, prior to using and pairing your headset for the first time ,please check if your mobile phone is Bluetooth-enable or not.

The headset pairing procedure may vary depending on the setting of your mobile phone.For further information, please contact the manufacture or distributor of your mobile phone.

Pairing Your Headset

1. Place the headset and the mobile phone in 1 meter range where they can be easily viewed.
2. Ensure the headset is turned off.
3. Press and hold the MFB for 5 seconds, blue&red indicator flash alternately, the headset begins to pair.
4. Activate the Bluetooth function on your mobile phone, according to your user guide of your mobile phone.
5. Set the mobile phone to search for Bluetooth devices within one meter and select "HF 665" from the list of devices shown.
6. Enter password "0000" and press "OK" to pair your headset with mobile phone ,when the pairing is completed , the headset enters standby mode.
(Note: If your Bluetooth mobile phone version is V2.1 or above, no need match password when using.)
7. Now you can use your Bluetooth headset to listen to the music and make a call.
8. Some mobile phones ,when they are re-started ,the headset will be connected with the mobile phone automatically.

Connect&Standby

Turn on the headset and click the "MFB" , it will connect the last connected mobile phone automatically if successfully connected and it will enter standby mode.

Wearing Your Headset

Please follow the Left/Right wearing note inside the headband, or ensure the button position on your right when wearing the HF 665.

Using Your Headset

• Bluetooth Operation Part

Answer a Call

When a call is coming, the ring tone will be heard by headset, press the MFB once to accept the call or answer the call via your mobile phone in normal way.

Call mute

During the call, double click the "MFB" to make the call mute and 2 "Du" tone will be heard. (Repeat to delete mute)

Transfer a Call

During the call, press&hold the "MFB" for 2 seconds after long tone "DU" is heard to transfer the call from your headset to your mobile phone. (Repeat to transfer to the headset)

Reject a Call

Double click the "MFB" to reject the incoming call.

End a Call

During the call, press the "MFB" once to end the call or hang up on your mobile phone.

Last call redialing

In standby mode, double click the "MFB" to redial the last call you made.

Voice Dialing

In standby mode, press the MFB button once and speak out the name which has been recorded in your contacts or the name that correspond to the number you want to dial.
Notice: prior to "HF 665" voice dialing, please make sure your mobile phone stored the voice tag: name. Ensure voice dialing function has been successfully activated on your mobile phone. Regarding how to record the voice tag, please refer to your devices user guide.

Play/Pause

When the Bluetooth headset was connected with stereo mobile phone , press "MFB" once to play music and press it once again to pause.

(Attention:your mobile phone must support A2DP profile.)

Previous Track

Connected with stereo mobile phone and playing music, press the "Previous Track " button to select the previous track.

Next Track

Connected with stereo mobile phone and playing music, press the "Next Track " key to select the next track.

Turn Up the Volume

(During calling/Bluetooth music/TF card music) Press the volume "+" once, the volume will be up. Each click per level, until MAX and you will hear "DU" alarm.

Warm Prompt: Adjust the volume properly to avoid any damages to your ears. Too big volume will be harmful to your ears!

Turn Down the Volume

(During calling/Bluetooth music/TF card music) Press the volume "-" once, the volume will be down. Each click per level, until Min and you will hear "DU" alarm.

• MP 3 Mode

Turn on/off MP3

Make sure the headset is in Bluetooth on status, press and hold the "MP3 On/Off Button" for 3 seconds after the green light display long time to enter. Press and hold the "MFB" for 5 seconds to turn it off.

Play/Pause

In MP3 mode, click the "MFB" to play the music in TF memory card and repeat to pause during music playing.
(Attention:your mobile phone must support A2DP profile.)

Previous Track

In MP3 music playing, click "Previous Track" to play the last song.

• FM Radio Mode

Turn on the FM radio

In MP3 mode, press and hold the "MFB" for 2 seconds to transfer from MP3 to FM radio mode. (Repeat to go back MP3)

FM Channel Searching Automatically

In FM radio mode, click the "MFB" and the green indicator flash quickly to enter FM channel searching, and store the channel automatically.

Turn Up the Volume in FM radio

(During FM radio or searching mode) Press the volume "+" once(with green indicator flashing), the volume will be up. Each click per level, until MAX and you will hear "DU" alarm.

Warm Prompt: Adjust the volume properly to avoid any damages to your ears. Too big volume will be harmful to your ears!

Turn Down the Volume in FM radio

(During FM radio or searching mode) Press the volume "-" once, the volume will be down. Each click per level, until Min and you will hear "DU" alarm.

FM Previous Channel

In FM radio mode, click "Previous Track" button to transfer to previous channel.

FM Next Channel

In FM radio mode, click "Next Track" button to transfer to next channel.

Use the 3.5mm Audio Music Cable

3.5 audio function can be available no matter in on or off status, sound of music will be cut down to the MIN volume in order not to affect the talk, the headset will return to music after call end.

Troubleshooting

If you are unable to connect your headset with mobile phone, please try the following steps :

Ensure your headset is turned on and is fully charged.

Ensure the headset is paired with your mobile phone.

Ensure your mobile phone's Bluetooth feature is activated. Please refer to your mobile phone user guide for specific instruction.

Ensure the headset is within a 10 meters range of your mobile headset and there are no with obstructions, such as walls or other electronic devices in between.

If the above steps do not solve your problem, please recharge the headset and remove your mobile phone battery for a short time.

Safety Information

Check local laws regarding the use of mobile phones and headsets while driving. If you use the headset while driving, ensure your attention and focus remains on the road and you drive in a responsible and safe manner.Never allow children playing with the headset small parts may be a choking hazard.

Observe all signs that require an electrical device or RF radio product to be switched off in designated areas.

(These could include hospitals, blasting areas, and potentially explosive environments.)

Turn off your headset prior to boarding an aircraft. Do not use your headset in an aircraft. Never mount or store your headset over any air bag development area as serious injury may result when the air bag deploys.

No not open or mutilate the built-in battery.

Dispose of batteries according to local regulations. Do not dispose as household waste.

Care and Maintenance Headset

Consider turning your headset off before placing it in your pocket or bag. If the MFB is accidentally activated., your mobile phone may place an unintended call.

Do not expose the headset to liquid, moisture or humidity as it is not waterproof.

Do not use abrasive cleaning solvents to clean the headset.

Do not expose the headset to extreme temperature conditions. The best store temperature range is from -10 to +60, otherwise the life of the headset will be influenced.

Do not dispose of the headset in a fire as it this may result in an explosion.

Do not bring your headset into contact with sharp objects as this will cause scratched and damage.

Do not attempt to disassemble the headset as it dose not contain serviceable components..

Do not attempt to Disassemble the headset.

If you do not use the headset for long periods, be sure to store it in a dry place, free form extreme temperature conditions and dust.
